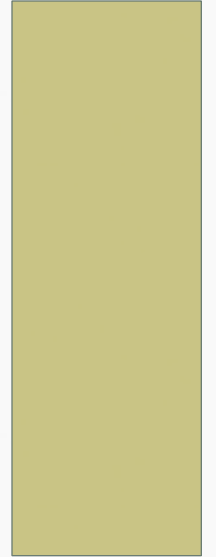

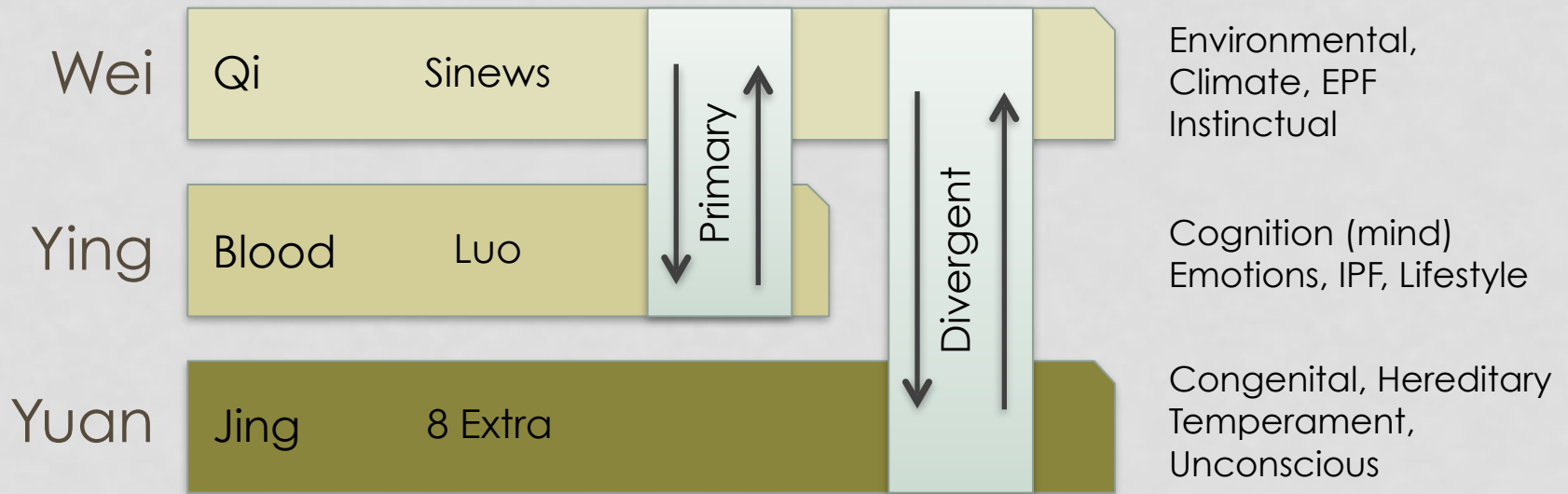

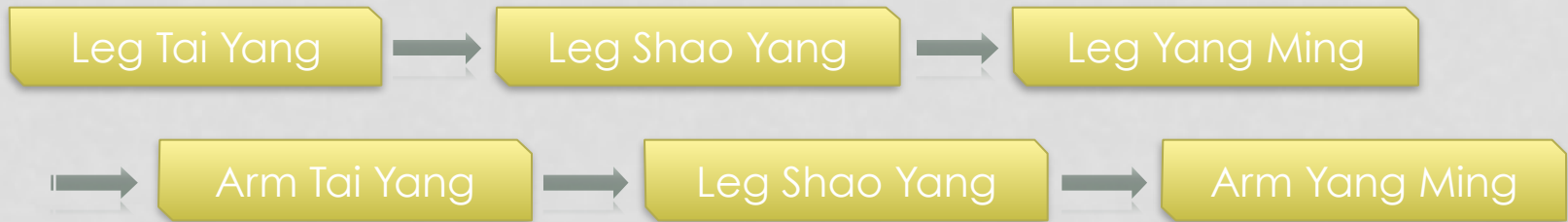


# CHANNEL SEQUENCE

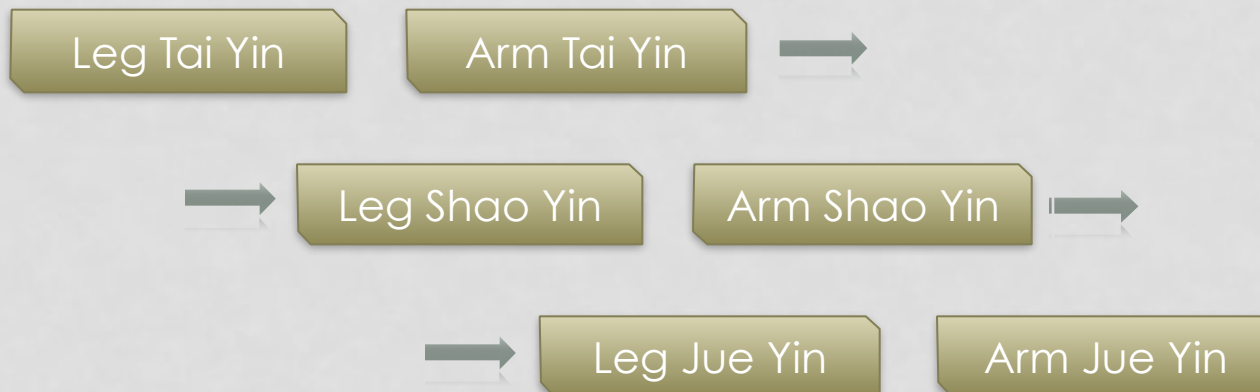
- Reflection of philosophy of the system

# SINEW CHANNEL SEQUENCE

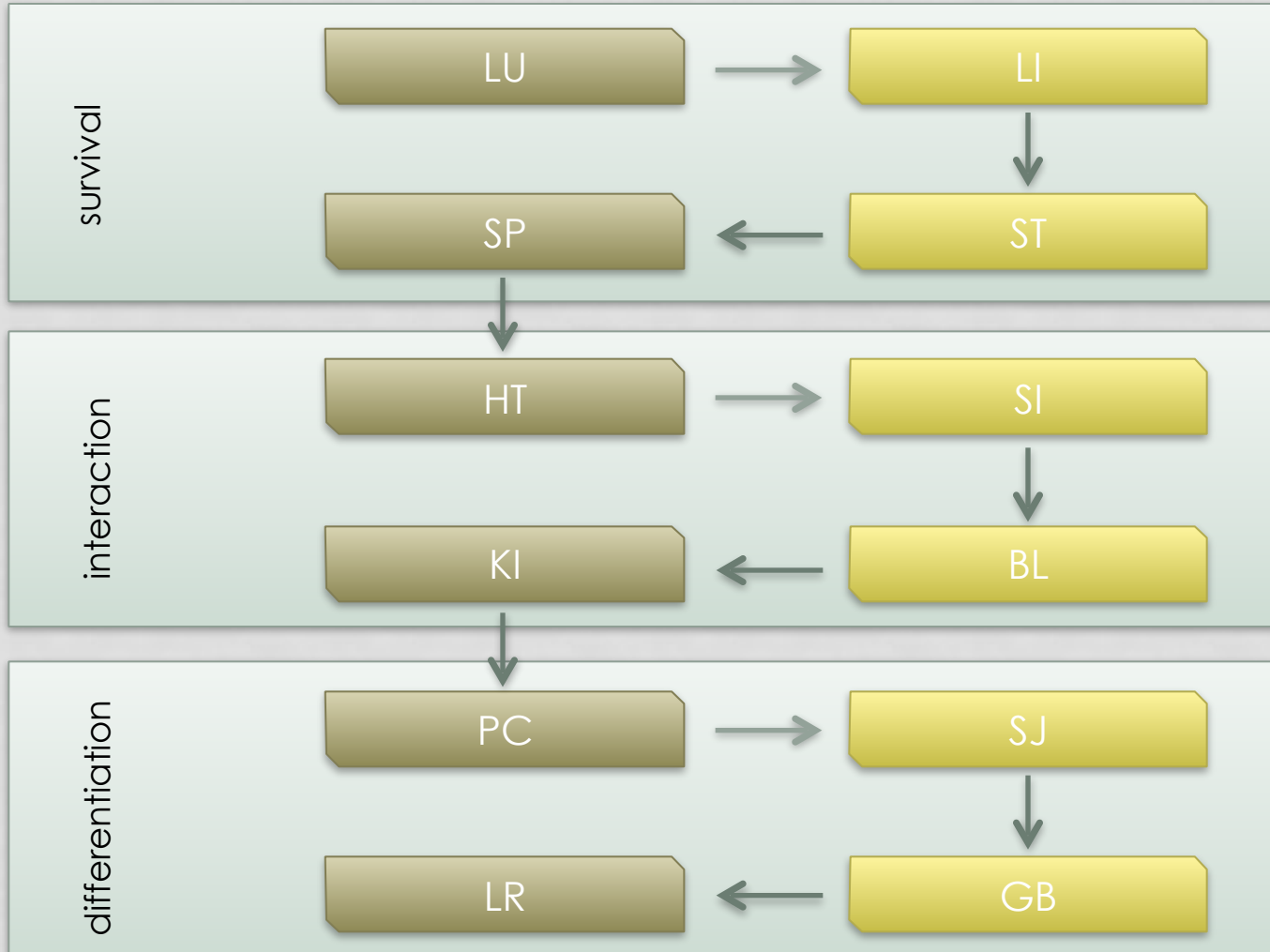

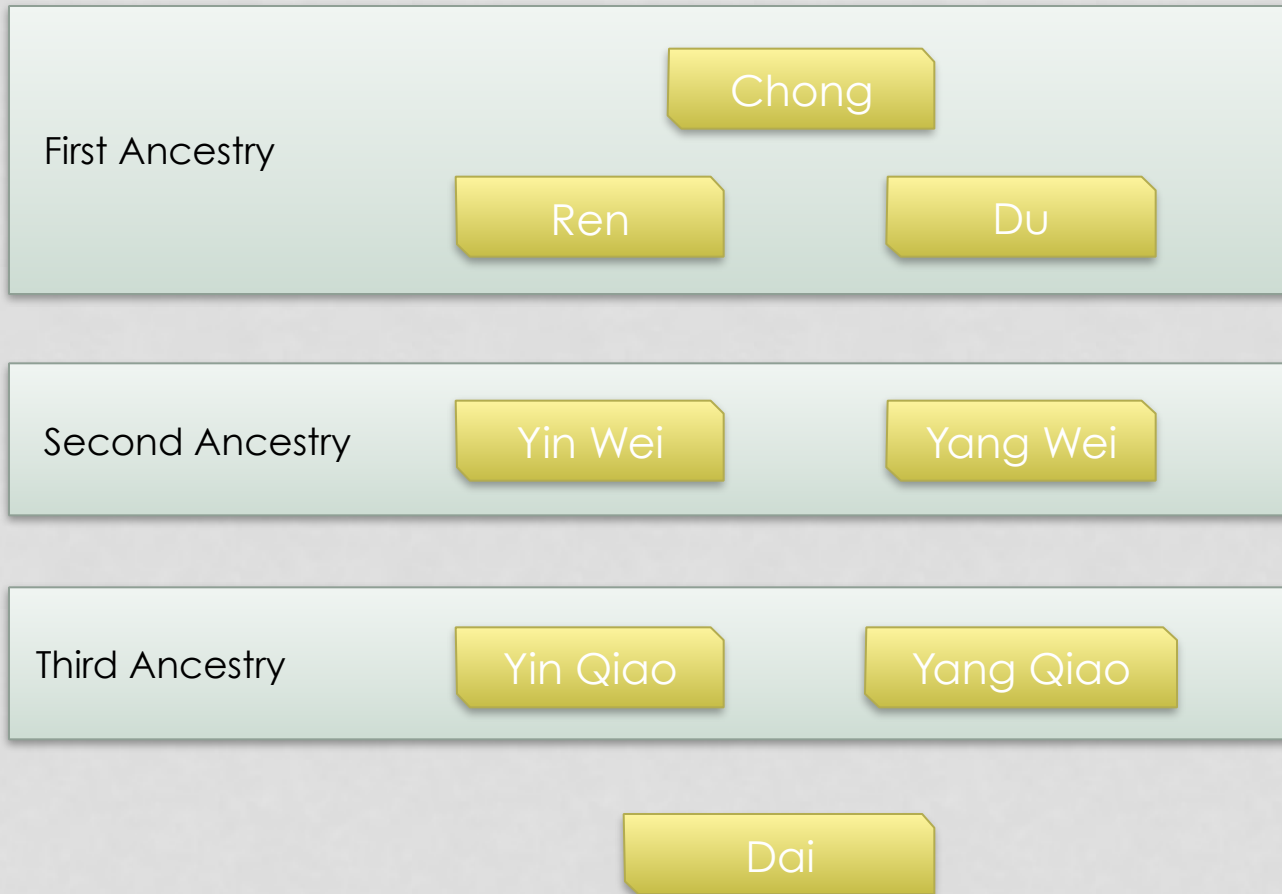

# CHANNELS OF PATHOLOGY

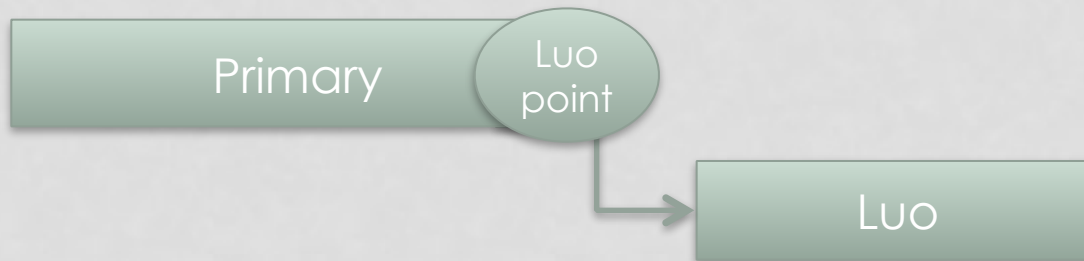
## LUO CHANNELS

### DIVERGENT CHANNELS

Created as needed

- Keep pathogens latent
- Keep pathogens away from ZF
- Financed with body's resources

# LUO CHANNELS



- Breaks away from primary channels
- Luo channels do not connect to ZF (\*HT,PC)
- Uses Ying (blood and Fluid) to hold pathology
- Visible
- Treated by bleeding
